Please remember to include your abstract's main title, your name, job title, company and contact information!

Tips for Writing a Successful Abstract

Presenting at a professional conference is an effective way to network and share your experiences and knowledge with like-minded individuals. Here are some tips for writing a successful abstract:

What is an Abstract?

- It is a short written document (250 to 500 words) that is intended to convey what your possible presentation will be about.
- It should engage the reader by clearly and succinctly telling them what the subject of your presentation will be and how that subject will be discussed throughout the presentation.
- The abstract should also include how the subject is relevant to heat exchangers, including Design & Specifications, Material Selection, Fabrication, Inspections, etc.

How Do I Write an Abstract?

Here are some questions to help you get started:

- What topic do I want to present on?
- Is this topic one that was specifically requested?
- Is this topic relevant to the conference theme and potential attendees?
- Can I successfully present this topic within the provided 20- to 25-minute time slot?

Abstract Submission Guidelines

- 250 to 500 words
- Should have a relevant main title
- Should clearly outline the presentation topic and scope of discussion
- Should be technical-based; please do not include any commercial or marketing content
- Please include your name, job title, company and contact details, including phone number and email address

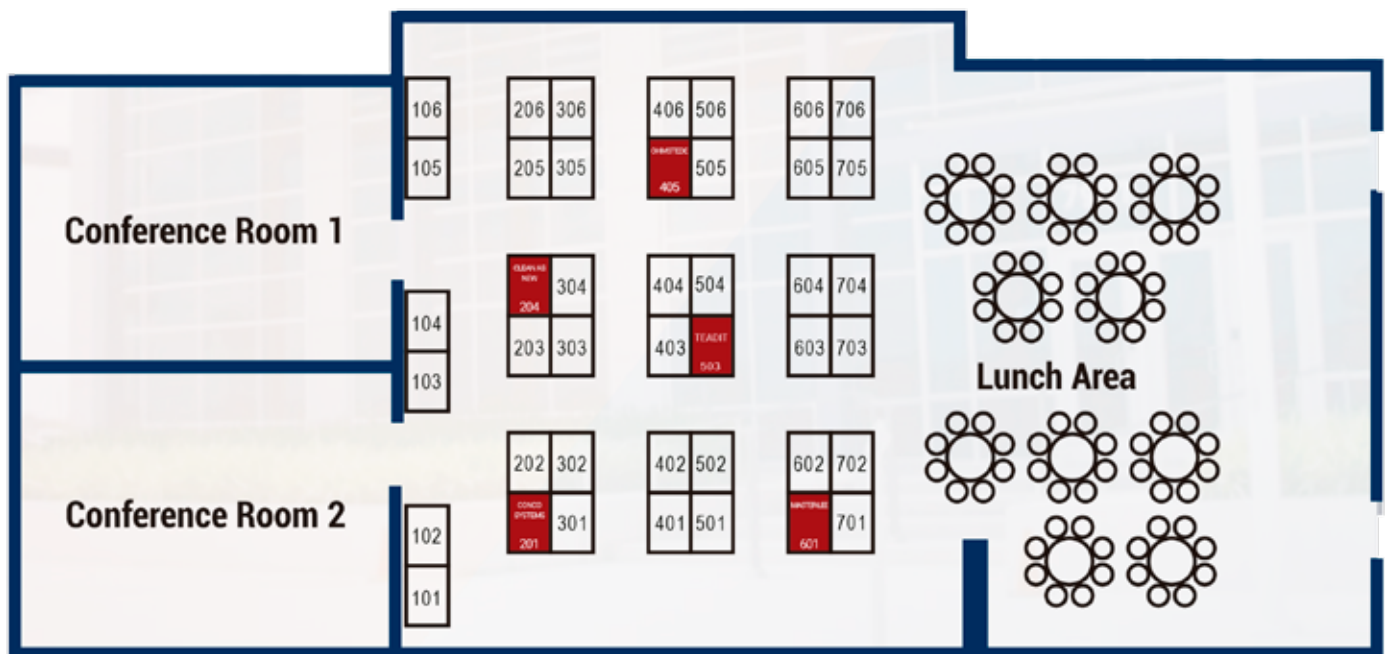
